The awards are reserved to PhD theses in Experimental Physics defended after 31/5/2018

Prizes: 1^{st} prize = 525 Euro 2^{nd} prize = 375 Euro 3^{rd} prize = 225 Euro

The argument of the PhD thesis must be coherent with the topics of the conference and must contain original results published or to be published in international journals.

In addition, the following fields can be considered:

- Laboratory plasmas;
- Astrophysics;
- Nuclear particle physics;
- Accelerators;
- Lasers;
- Medical and industrial equipment.

In order to apply for the CAEN Award, you have to send the following documentation:

- application form for the CAEN Prize for Experimental Physics 2022 duly filled in all its parts;
- copy of your thesis;
- copy of your thesis abstract;

- support statement (max 30 words) from a reviewer highlighting the significance of the PhD project methods and results.
